

RCSS - Staying Safe During the Elections

Guidelines for Staff & Volunteers

Identification and Visibility

- Always wear RCSS uniform and ID badge
- Ensure the Red Cross emblem is clearly visible



Movement and Access

- Follow designated routes to polling stations
- Inform supervisor before moving between locations



Neutral **Presence**

- Remain neutral and impartial
- No political discussions, banners, or symbols
- Professional conduct at all times

Response

- Prioritize personal safety first
- 🧪 Withdraw to a safe area if unrest occurs
- Treat casualty in a safe area.
- Report all incidents immediately to your supervisor

Team Safety

- Work in pairs or teams - never alone
- Maintain regular communication with your team leader/operations center



Health and Well-being

- Stay hydrated and take breaks when possible
- Use protective equipment (masks, gloves, first-aid kits) when providing car

A Remember: A safe and protected volunteer is better able to serve the community.
